The ARcana are the 22 major archetypes of the traditional tarot deck. What I've done is taken these guides and asked them to share their secrets. What has come, and is in the book, is an action, a purpose from each one designed to acknowledge the human condition, to reveal and remove obstacles and incorrect beliefs.

They are like grand actors on the world stage, just like us. What they are showing the reader is how to drop the worn out limiting conditions so the jewels of our regal nature take center stage and we truly live. They are profound yet simple, and only ask that we show up earnestly, that we wake up to the fact that we are much grander that we take ourselves to be, especially when we understand how to go beyond what is limited, and that we exist beyond our body and our minds. Seeds of real knowledge are planted, and any valuable seeds that are there already will begin to flower and bear fruit. It's about being in mastery of your self.

You can't miss this train. I am directly targeting whatever notion in you that is ready. What I am offering is that you get on board, save yourself a lot of time, and put your own pedal to the metal to discover more and more the unique gift that you are, so you live from the experience of that, be it and share it.
